### NIH Security

In preparation for accessing NIH's campus, all workshop attendees (even those who have been to NIH before) are encouraged to review the detailed [Campus Access and Security](#), including [new requirements](#) for visitors. NIH visitors are *required* to:

- Enter via the [NIH Gateway Center](#).
- Show a [government-issued REAL ID](#) and provide information about the visit. Use the [Department of Homeland Security checker](#) to learn if you already have a REAL ID.

**Are you a US citizen?** *NIH security pre-screening is required for non-US citizens.* Event staff will assist with pre-screening activities, so please be sure to correctly answer this question when registering for the workshop.


Be sure to **allow at least 45 minutes** to pass through NIH security. The [NIH Visitor Map](#) has additional information about security requirements (including vehicle inspection if dropping materials off at the Natcher Conference Center).

### Food and Beverage Options on campus include:

- Natcher Conference Center cafeteria is open for coffee and snacks from 8:00 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. with:
  - Breakfast served 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m.
  - Lunch served 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

### Getting to NIH

**Public Transportation.** Because parking is *extremely* limited, attendees are encouraged to use Metro . Metro provides [trip planning tools](#) (including schedules and maps), and additional public transportation information is available from the [Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority website](#). If taking Metro, exit at the Medical Center stop.

**Taxi/Rideshare Dropoff.** If arriving by rideshare or taxicab, ask to be dropped off at the Medical Center Metro stop.

**Parking.** Attendees are strongly encouraged to take Metro, but if you *must* drive, extremely limited parking may be available for a fee. Vehicles should enter via NIH Gateway Drive off Route 355 – Rockville Pike (southbound only) and park in the [MLP 11 garage](#) (see map).
